Learning Plan	Time
 A. Introduce Review the Expectations Chart: Read and discuss. Ask students to explain what they think these expectations look like and sound like in the cafeteria. Line students up according to your expectations and prepare to go to the lunchroom. Remind students of the hallway behaviors that you have already discussed. Walk students to the lunchroom and go through lunchroom procedures or act them out in the classroom. 	10-15 minutes
 B. Demonstrate/Model behavior expectations. (This may be done ahead of time or when you take them to lunch.) 1. Walk students through all the steps: Entering, getting milk, getting food, entering lunch number, walking to the table, sitting down and raising hand if additional items are needed. Reinforce the expectations from the chart for each step. 2. Once students are seated, talk with them about the expected behaviors while they are eating in the lunchroom. 3. Then, go through the procedure for cleaning up (putting all trash on your tray, waiting until the table is called, putting lunch trays away, and lining up quietly in the lunchroom). 	10-15 minutes
 C. Demonstrate or discuss examples of NOT following the behavior expectations. 1. Respectful - Examples of NOT being respectful (yelling across the table, saying unkind words, taking food off of someone's tray). 3. Respecting Environment - Examples of NOT respecting the environment (not picking up dropped food, napkins, or utensils, throwing food etc.)
